ORDER

On February 15, 2023, the appellant, Sandy Drummond, filed a notice of appeal from a Justice of the Peace Court order dated February 10, 2023. The Senior Court Clerk issued a notice, sent by certified mail, directing Drummond to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed based on the Court's lack of jurisdiction to consider an appeal from the Justice of the Peace Court.
