ORDER

This 30th day of May 2001, it appears to the Court that on April 24, 2001, Michael D. Johnson filed a petition for a writ of mandamus seeking to compel the Superior Court to modify his Level IV sentence.¹ Johnson had asked for similar relief in a petition for writ of habeas corpus filed in the Superior Court on April 17, 2001. On April 25, 2001, the Superior Court held a hearing on Johnson's habeas corpus petition and reduced Johnson's sentence.²

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Johnson's petition for a writ of mandamus is DISMISSED as moot.
