## <u>ORDER</u>

This 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 2012, it appears to the Court that:

(1) The defendant-appellant, European Performance, Inc., has petitioned this Court, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 42, to accept an appeal from an interlocutory order of the Superior Court dated April 17, 2012. The trial court's order denied European Performance's motions for summary judgment or partial summary judgment.
