## <u>O R D E R</u>

This 19<sup>th</sup> day of June 2003, upon consideration of the parties' briefs and the record below, the Court finds it manifest that this matter should be affirmed on the basis of the Superior Court's well-reasoned decision dated January 15, 2003.
