O R D E R

This 15th day of September 2000, upon consideration of the briefs of the parties it appears to the Court that the Superior Court correctly interpreted the written contract between the plaintiff-below appellant, Thomas F. Lapinski (“Lapinski”), and the defendant-below appellee, Board of Education of the Brandywine School District (the “District”), as fixing Lapinski’s entitlement to salary for the second through fourth years of his contract as an administrator for the District. Accordingly, the Superior Court did not err in granting summary judgment in favor of the District.
