On consideration of the certified order of the Supreme Court of Maryland disbaring respondent from the practice of law in that jurisdiction, *see Attorney Grievance Com'n of Maryland v. Assaraf*, 21 A.3d 618(Md., 2011), this court's July 25, 2011, amended order suspending respondent pending further action of the court and directing him to show cause why identical reciprocal discipline should not be imposed, respondent's response and affidavit required by D.C. Bar R. XI, §14 (g), and the statement of Bar Counsel regarding reciprocal discipline, it is

ORDERED that Steven M. Assaraf is hereby disbarred from the practice of law in the District of Columbia, *nunc pro tunc* to August 3, 2011. *See In re Fuller*, 930 A.2d 194, 198 (D.C. 2007), and *In re Willingham*, 900 A.2d 165 (D.C. 2006) (rebuttable presumption of identical reciprocal discipline applies to all cases in which the respondent does not participate, including those involving disbarment).
