ORDER

On July 19, 2010, Defendant-Appellant City of Albuquerque filed an unopposed motion requesting that the appendix to its opening brief be filed under seal. On July 21, 2010, the Clerk of the Court provisionally granted Appellant's motion, with the ultimate determination referred to the merits panel. At oral argument on this matter on January 19, 2011, the parties agreed that they could redact the appendix to preclude disclosure of any information that may potentially identify Appellee.

Accordingly, the parties shall, within 60 days of the filing of this Order, (1) meet and agree on the redactions necessary to allow the appendix to be filed publicly without

disclosing Appellee's identity; and (2) file a redacted version of the appendix, which shall not be filed under seal. The current appendix shall remain under seal.
