SUBJECT: Signature Authority

- 1.) The signature authority of the City of Albuquerque is vested in the Mayor as the Chief Executive of the City, unless otherwise delegated.
- 2.) Signature authority for the City of Albuquerque is herewith delegated to the Chief Administrative Officer, unless specifically reserved to the Mayor by statute, ordinance or regulation.
- 3.) In the absence of a Chief Administrative Officer, the Mayor may appoint an acting Chief Administrative Officer. All signature authority delegated to the Chief Administrative Officer is vested in the acting Chief Administrative Officer.
- 4.) The Chief Administrative Officer may delegate vested signature authority by administrative directive or instruction.
