Demetria Nicole Williams, appointed counsel for Johnny Goodman in his

appeal of the district court's denial of his motion to reduce his sentence pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2), has filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967), and moved to withdraw from further representation of the appellant.
