PER CURIAM:

Jorge Leon Chalela, appointed counsel for Alma Borja, has filed a motion to

withdraw on appeal supported by a brief prepared pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct. Because independent examination of the entire record reveals no issues of arguable merit, counsel's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED** and Borja's convictions and sentences are **AFFIRMED**.
