
Dear Mr. Ley:

This letter confirms my request for a seven-day extension of time for Appellants to file their initial brief and record excerpts in Case No. 12-15147. I have conferred with Appellees counsel, and they do not oppose this request.

The parties also plan to jointly move the Court for a forty-five day extension of time for the Appellees to file their brief (or briefs) in the above-referenced appeals, and for a thirty-day extension of time for Appellants to file their reply brief (or briefs).
