William Randal Clark appeals the denial of his motion for attorneys' fees, which he filed a year and a day after the plaintiffs herein filed their notice of voluntary dismissal of this action. In a 34-page opinion in which he recounted the facts of this case with which he was personally and thoroughly familiar, Judge O'Kelley denied the motion as untimely.
