Gerald Scott Bettman, appointed counsel for Jaceta Anya Streeter in this direct criminal appeal, has filed a motion to withdraw from further representation

of Streeter, supported by a brief prepared under *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Our independent review of the entire record reveals that counsel's assessment of the relative merit of the appeal is correct.
