## PER CURIAM:

Wilfredo Gonzalez Lora appeals the district court's order denying his motion filed under Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b), in which he sought reconsideration of the court's prior order dismissing his breach of contract action. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
