PER CURIAM:

Sukhdev Singh, a native and citizen of India, petitions for review of an order of the Board of Immigration Appeals ("Board") denying his motion to reopen immigration proceedings. We have reviewed the record and the Board's order and find that the Board did not abuse its discretion in denying Singh's motion to reopen as untimely. See 8 C.F.R. § 1003.2(a) (2006).
