PER CURIAM:

Brotherly Love, LLC, appeals from the district court's order affirming the bankruptcy court's order granting the motion of the debtor, Muhsen A. Haddad, to dismiss his Chapter 7 bankruptcy case. We have reviewed the record and decisions of the bankruptcy court and the district court and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm. See In re O'Brien Envtl. Energy, Inc., 181 F.3d 527, 531 (3d Cir. 1999).
