PER CURIAM:

Prabhu Mohapatra appeals the district court's order adopting the recommendation of a magistrate judge and entering default judgment against him and three corporate defendants in this action for trademark infringement and unfair competition brought by America Online, Inc. ("AOL"). After a review of the record, we find no error, and we therefore affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See America Online, Inc. v. Mohapatra, No. 1:05-cv-00535-CMH (E.D. Va.
