PER CURIAM:

Michael A. Webb appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint without prejudice for failure to state a claim under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(A)(6)(1). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Webb v. Ray, 7:06-CV-00343-gec-mf (W.D. Va. June 6, 2006).^{*} We deny Webb's motion for summary judgment.
