## PER CURIAM:

In these consolidated appeals, Paul Yongo appeals the district court's orders accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing his civil complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2000), and denying reconsideration.
