PER CURIAM:

Henry Joseph Borelli, a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (2000) petition. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See Borelli v. Driver, 2:06-cv-00087-REM (N.D.W. Va. filed May 4, 2007 & entered May 7, 2007). Additionally, we deny Borelli's "Emergency Application for Temporary Injunction" as moot and deny his motion to amend the caption in this case.
