PER CURIAM:

Paul R. Jones petitions for a writ of mandamus seeking an order compelling the United States Attorney General to investigate an Arizona district court in connection with a civil action in that court. We conclude that we lack jurisdiction to issue the requested writ. <u>See Gurley v. Superior Court of</u> <u>Mecklenburg County</u>, 411 F.2d 586, 587 (4th Cir. 1969). Accordingly, we dismiss the petition for writ of mandamus.
