PER CURIAM:

Carroll Eugene Dodson appeals the district court's order reducing his sentence, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2000), from 524 to 456 months of imprisonment. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See United States v. Dodson, No. 7:94-cr-40106-jlk-1 (W.D. Va.
