PER CURIAM:

Derrick Edward Brown appeals the district court's order denying his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006) motion for reduction of his sentence. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. See United States v. Dunphy, 551 F.3d 247 (4th Cir. 2009); United States v. Hood, 556 F.3d 226 (4th Cir. 2009). Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons set forth by the district court.
