## PER CURIAM:

Samuel Benjamin Kelly appeals the district court's orders denying his motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2000) for a reduction of sentence and his Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(e) motion to alter or amend judgment. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v.
