PER CURIAM:

James T. Bellamy, a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (2006) petition. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Bellamy v. Bauknecht, No. 6:07-cv-02656-RBH (D.S.C. July 11, 2008).
