PER CURIAM:

David Bright appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Bright v. O'Flaherty, No. 1:08-cv-00699-RWT (D. Md. Oct. 16, 2008). We further deny Bright's motions to remand and to appoint counsel.
