PER CURIAM:

Demond O'Neil Parker appeals the district court's order granting his motion for reduction of sentence, 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c) (2006). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Parker's motions to vacate the district court's order, appoint counsel, and remand the case, and we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v. Parker, No. 6:99-cr-70054-nkm-9 (W.D. Va. Oct. 20, 2008).
