## PER CURIAM:

Oyoyo Adanna Ebuzoeme, a native and citizen of the United Kingdom, petitions for review of an order of the Board of Immigration Appeals ("Board") denying her motion to reopen immigration proceedings. We have reviewed the record and the Board's order and find that the Board did not abuse its discretion in denying the motion. See 8 C.F.R. § 1003.2(a) (2009). Accordingly, we deny the petition for review for the reasons stated by the Board. See In re: Ebuzoeme (B.I.A. Dec. 24, 2008).
