PER CURIAM:

Michael Brunell Flanigan appeals the district court's order dismissing his complaint filed pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388 (1971), without prejudice for failure to comply with a court order. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See Flanigan v. United States, No. 2:08-cv-00446-MSD-TEM (E.D. Va. filed Mar. 6, 2009 & entered Mar. 9, 2009).
