PER CURIAM:

Lashon Maurice Gaither appeals the district court's order denying his motion for reduction of sentence pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v. Gaither, No. 5:05-cr-00009-RLV-DCK-10 (W.D.N.C. Feb. 27, 2009); see United States v. Hood, 556 F.3d 226, 232-36 (4th Cir. 2009), cert. denied, \_\_ U.S. \_\_, 2009 WL 2496498 (U.S. Oct. 5, 2009) (No. 09-5868).
