PER CURIAM:

Saul Garcia-Benitez appeals the district court's order denying his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006) motion for reduction of sentence based on Amendment 706 to the United States Sentencing Guidelines. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v. Garcia-Benitez, No. 5:06-cr-00046-GEC-3 (W.D. Va.
