PER CURIAM:

Yul Carter petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging the district court has unduly delayed acting on his motion to alter or amend judgment. He seeks an order from this court directing the district court to act. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that the district court denied the motion on July 1, 2010. Accordingly, because the district court has recently decided Carter's case, we deny the mandamus petition as moot.
