PER CURIAM:

Fausto Cepeda appeals the district court's order denying his motion filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006), which sought a reduction in sentence based on the amendments to the crack cocaine sentencing guidelines. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v. Cepeda, No. 3:93-cr-00128-JRS-1 (E.D. Va.
