PER CURIAM:

Jessie Scott appeals the district court's order denying his motion to reconsider the denial of his motion for reduction of sentence under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See United States v. Scott, No. 1:04-cr-00453-TSE-1 (E.D.
