PER CURIAM:

Patrick O. Christian appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2006). We have reviewed the record and find that this appeal is frivolous. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for the reasons stated by the district court. Christian v. Moore, No. 3:10-cv-00302-FDW-DSC (W.D.N.C. Aug. 30, 2010).
