Plaintiffs, Atlantic Marina Holdings LLC and Miller Development LLC, appeal the district court's order granting Defendant's Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6) motion to dismiss their South Carolina law claims for breach of contract, conversion, unjust enrichment, and violation of the South Carolina Unfair Trade Practices Act, S.C. Code Ann. § 39-5 (1985 & Supp. 2010). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's judgment. See Atlantic Marina Holdings LLC v. Madison Capital Co. LLC, No. 2:10-cv-02016-RMG (D.S.C. Dec. 20, 2010).
