Charles E. Carter seeks to appeal the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and judgment to the Clarendon County Fire granting summary Department. This court may exercise jurisdiction only over final orders, 28 U.S.C. § 1291 (2006), and certain interlocutory and collateral orders, 28 U.S.C. § 1292 (2006); Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b); Cohen v. Beneficial Indus. Loan Corp., 337 U.S. 541, 545-46 (1949). The order Carter seeks to appeal is neither a final order nor an appealable interlocutory or collateral order. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for lack of jurisdiction. dispense with oral argument because the facts and contentions are adequately presented in the materials before the court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
