PER CURIAM:

Terence Jerome Richardson appeals the district court's order denying his motion for reconsideration of the denial of his motion for reduction of sentence pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006). Because the district court lacked the authority to consider Richardson's motion for reconsideration, see United States v. Goodwyn, 596 F.3d 233, 235-36 (4th Cir.), cert. denied, 130 S. Ct. 3530 (2010), we affirm the district court's order denying the motion.
