## PER CURIAM:

Ralph and Beverly Byrd appeal the district court's order affirming the bankruptcy court's order appointing a Chapter 11 trustee, denying their motion for reconsideration of the appointment, approving the applications to employ special counsel to the trustee, and approving the application for compensation.
