PER CURIAM:

Lawrence and Elge L. Traber appeal from the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing their action in which they asserted a claim pursuant to the Federal Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act, and a claim for quiet title under North Carolina law. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Traber v. Mortg. Elec. Registration Sys.
