PER CURIAM:
Westmoreland Coal Company petitions for review of the Benefits Review Board's ("Board") decision and order affirming the Administrative Law Judge's ("ALJ") grant of benefits to former employee Carl Ramey under the Black Lung Benefits Act, 30 U.S.C. §§ 901-945 (2006). Our review of the record reveals that the ALJ's decision is based upon substantial evidence and is without reversible error. Accordingly, we deny the petition for review for the reasons stated by the Board. Westmoreland Coal Co. v. Dir., Office of Workers' Comp. Programs, No. 11-0807-BLA (Aug. 31, 2012).
