PER CURIAM:

Ophelia Azriel De'Lonta appeals the district court's order denying relief on her complaint alleging violations under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) and the Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act ("RLUIPA"), 42 U.S.C. § 2000cc (2006). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. De'Lonta v. Johnson, No. 7:11-cv-00175-JCT-RSB (W.D. Va. July 17, 2012).
