PER CURIAM:

Robert A. Zander appeals the district court's order dismissing without prejudice for failure to exhaust administrative remedies his complaint filed pursuant to <u>Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics</u>, 403 U.S. 388 (1971).* We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, although we grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. <u>Zander v. Lappin</u>, No. 5:08-ct-03117-FL (E.D.N.C. Aug. 1, 2012). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
