PER CURIAM:

Tony Lee Belton appeals the district court's order adopting the magistrate judge's recommendation to grant Defendants' motion to dismiss his civil rights action alleging violations of his constitutional rights while incarcerated at the Orangeburg-Calhoun Regional Detention Center. Belton has also moved for appointment of counsel. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
