PER CURIAM:

Raoul Lafond appeals from the district court's order denying his motion for reduction of sentence pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c) (2006). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v. Lafond, No. 6:96-cr-00212-WO-1 (M.D.N.C. Oct. 31, 2012). Additionally, we deny Lafond's motion for release pending appeal, for an en banc hearing, and for this court to assume jurisdiction over his motion pending in the district court.
