PER CURIAM:

Nicholas James Queen, Sr., petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging the district court has unduly delayed acting on his 28 U.S.C. § 2255 (West Supp. 2012) motion. He seeks an order from this court directing the district court to act. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that the district court denied relief on the § 2255 motion by order entered on January 28, 2013.
