PER CURIAM:

Theodore Wagner appeals the district court's orders adopting the magistrate judge's recommendation and dismissing as frivolous his civil complaint, and denying his motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Wagner v.
