PER CURIAM:

Gabriel Neal petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging the district court has unduly delayed acting on his 28 U.S.C. § 2255 (2012) motion. He seeks an order from this court directing the district court to act. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that the district court entered an order granting summary judgment in favor of Respondent on January 16, 2014.
