PER CURIAM:

James David Wesley Carr appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2012). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See Carr v. Seifert, No. 3:13-cv-00040-GMG-JSK (N.D. W. Va.
