PER CURIAM:

Steven R. Estes appeals from the tax court's order upholding the Commissioner of Internal Revenue's determinations with respect to Estes' income tax liability for the 2004, 2005, and 2006 tax years and upholding the Commissioner's proposed collection activities.
